This award will allow competent swimmers to work towards becoming potential lifesavers and gain awareness of the beach environment. This award is to encourage personal life saving skills for emergency situations that may occur and provide stepping stones to becoming a professional Beach Lifeguard.

<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Identify basic water safety; rescue procedures and sun smart and local dangers for your local beach 2. Demonstrate basic resuscitation and first aid treatment on an adult casualty 3. Demonstrate intermediate survival skills in either the pool or ocean 4. Demonstrate intermediate rescue skills on a simulated patient. You can use a pool or the shallows of a small shore break 5. Describe environmental and communication factors for the beach environment
