This award will allow competent swimmers to work towards becoming potential lifesavers and gain awareness of the beach environment. This award is to encourage personal life saving skills and provide stepping stones to becoming a professional Beach Lifeguard.

Demonstrate basic resuscitation and first aid treatment on an adult casualty 3. Demonstrate basic survival skills in either the pool or ocean 4. Demonstrate basic rescue skills on a simulated patient. You can use a pool or the shallows of a small shore break 5. Describe basic environmental and communication factors for the beach environment

This course can be Coach/Trainer Assessed (All first aid elements must be delivered by a Trainer Assessor) Learners will be assessed using a variety of assessment methods.
