PATROL CAPTAIN

You are the highest qualified SLSGB Life Saver.
You control and manage SLSGB Patrols declared to the Coast Guard.

SURF LIFE GUARD

You are the highest qualified SLSGB Lifeguard.
You lead patrols declared to the Coast Guard in a coastal environment.

FIRST RESPONDER

You provide Level 3 Pre Hospital Care.
You are a fully competent team member of Level 2, 3, 4 and 5 Patrols declared to the Coast Guard.

SURF COACH SAFETY AND RESCUE

You provide water safety cover managed at all times by a qualified Lifeguard.
You can be part of any Patrol declared to the Coast Guard.

NATIONAL VOCATIONAL BEACH LIFEGUARD

You are a Beach Lifeguard holding a recognised National Vocational Award.
You can be a member of all patrols declared to the Coast Guard but do not replace a Surf Life Guard.

INLAND WATERS LIFEGUARD

You are an Inland Lifeguard for rivers and lakes.
You can be part of any Patrol declared to the Coast Guard, and other statutory organisations.

LEVEL 2 INTERMEDIATE FIRST AIDER

You deliver enhanced first aid to all in need and may be a member of all patrols declared to the Coast Guard but do not replace or substitute a First Responder.

SURF LIFESAVER

You are an assistant lifesaver always supervised by a qualified Lifeguard.
You can be part of a Level 3 and 4 patrol declared to the Coast Guard.

GRADUATE LIFEGUARD PROGRAMME

You can under supervision assist with club training safety, deliver safety messages to local communities and qualify as a Surf Lifeguard as soon as you are 16.
You can be part of any Patrol declared to the Coast Guard.

BEACH LIFEGUARD SUPPORT

You do everything that a Beach Lifeguard does. You do not undertake any wet side rescue activity.
You can be part of any Patrol declared to the Coast Guard.

LEVEL 1 EMERGENCY FIRST AIDER

You deliver basic first aid to adults only and if 16, may be a member of all patrols declared to the Coast Guard but do not replace or substitute a First Responder.

RESCUE BOARD PADDLER

Using a Rescue Board, you provide club water safety cover managed at all times by a qualified Lifeguard.
You can be part of a Level 3 or 4 Patrol declared to the Coastguard.

TUBE RESCUER

Using a Rescue Tube, you provide club water safety cover managed at all times by a qualified Lifeguard.
You can be part of a Level 3 or 4 Patrol declared to the Coastguard.

COASTAL SURVEILLANCE PATROL

You provide an important safety service for those that you observe are in danger or needing help by contacting a rescue service who will respond.
You can patrol on your own or with others and may be a member of all Patrols declared to the Coast Guard.
