This Award will also allow the candidate to deliver the Level 1 Assistant Coach and Trainer Assessor Qualifications at club level supported by the National Education and Training Manager. | |

| By the end of this course all learners will be able to: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Explain the principles of coaching• Explain how to maintain a safe and equitable coaching environment• Explain basic nutrition and hydration principles, physical conditioning and mental preparation for sport• Describe the principles of skills development that can impact on coaching sessions• Demonstrate an understanding of each stage of course set-up and delivery | |

| Candidates on this course will usually be assessed by the Coach Trainer that delivered their training, to include; <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Demonstration of coaching technique• Log 10 hours as a Level 2 Lead Coach under the supervision of a qualified mentor• Completion of Level 2 Coach Assessment Workbook• Successful completion of Myagi Online Learning Tests | |

| This is a two day classroom based course (although practical may also be included in the water at the discretion of the Coach Trainer) followed by 10 hours of logged lead coach activity under the supervision of a Mentor. | |

(please note the first courses that you deliver must be supervised by a Mentor) |
