Assessment Process:	
Candidates on this course will usually be assessed by the Coach Trainer that delivered their training, to include; <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Demonstration of coaching technique• Demonstration of techniques used to support the development of other volunteers• Completion of Level 2 Coach Assessment Workbook• Successful completion of Myagi Online Learning Tests

This is a one-day theory and practical course. Practical will always be land based and used as a demonstration of coaching styles, techniques, and activity ideas.
