COVID-19 Event Conditions

It is an absolute requirement of event entry that all Team Members have seen, read and agree to adhere to these conditions before attending The Event location. You will be asked to confirm this at Registration. Any observed breach may be subject to instant disqualification of the Team and a request to go home without delay

1. All entrants and named helpers must provide a C-19 Declaration completed in two stages:-
Stage 1- Initial, at the time of entry to the Club immediately prior to submission of the entry
Stage 2 Confirmation, emailed direct to the Organiser **by 5.0 pm on the 7th October 2020**

A copy of the required Declaration is appended

2. If any member of the Team or a helper feels ill at The Event and is displaying C-19 symptoms, they must immediately self-isolate within the allocated Team area and the Team Manager must inform the event C-19 Safety Officer (can be contacted on VHF by a Steward)
3. Team members and Helpers should not share transport to and from the event unless in the same family they share a house with.
4. Teams must arrive at Registration together at the time allocated to them to register. If travelling separately they should meet up outside the event area and not enter the event area until registered
5. All entrants and named helpers by entering The Event agree to maintain social distancing (2m or 1m wearing a face mask) at all times other than when in the water competing. When in the water competing and during starts and finishes all competitors agree to adapt face away from face at all times and to avoid close physical contact
6. Competitor ID will be by a personal competition number written on the back of the right hand in indelible bold marker pen. **TEAMS MUST BRING AND USE THEIR OWN MARKER PENS** and the ID must be seen on the hand at registration. Helpers acting as Stewards will be issue with ID tags
7. All Team members agree to abide by strict social distancing at all times whilst attending the event and to avoid all social gatherings of more than 6 people
8. Whilst moving from area to area within the competition (to and from designated start and finish areas) competitors will not linger or group together and will follow directions given by The Event Stewards
9. Teams have been allocated their own Team Area and are asked to stay within that area at all times possible and practical when not competing and to avoid clusters at Start and Finish areas and all Team support shouting or energetic vocal

outbursts (No cluster/group support, no physical close contact either vocal or actual please)

10. All Kit should be sanitised before loading for the journey to The Event and upon arrival on return to home.
11. Team Kit (Skis and Boards must only be handled by members of the same team and when not in use kept in and returned without delay to the secure Team allocated area. Whilst at The Event and when practicable, regular cleaning should take place after each use by vigorous washing in sea water.
12. Handling of kit during The Event should be restricted to the user and when necessary one other only.
13. Teams must bring their own PPE, sanitisers and hand gel and use frequently and appropriately.
14. Bring your own identified bags for contaminated waste (tissues and paper towels)
